Notable examples are the heroic Zulu warrior Umslopogaas and Ignosi, the rightful king of Kukuanialand, in King Solomon’s Mines.

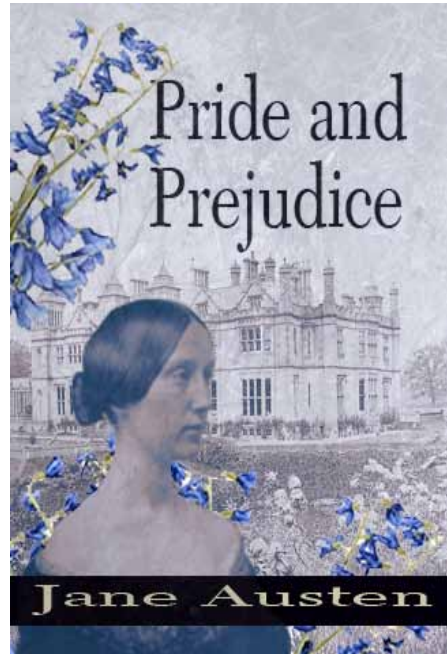

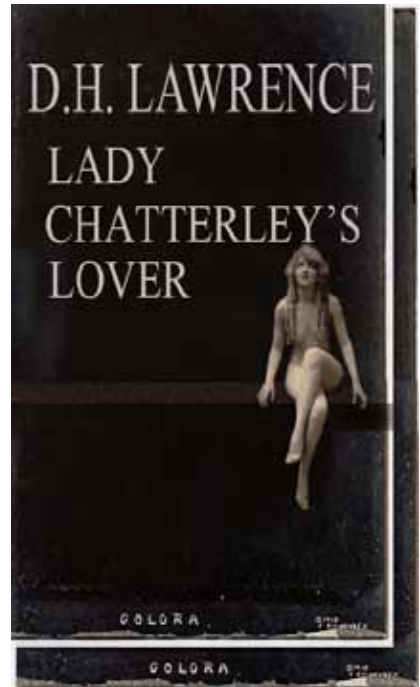

Forster, in an obituary notice, challenged this widely held view, describing him as "the greatest imaginative novelist of our generation."
